



KSU Green Fund 2019

Definitions:

KSU shall mean Kunsill Studenti Universitarji as elected/ appointed through an election held by the AGM's appointed Electoral Commissioners and through the Education and Social Policy Commissions.

The Board shall be appointed through a KSU resolution according to these Regulations.

The Board of Appeal shall be appointed through a KSU resolution according to these Regulations.

Applicant shall refer to any University of Malta Student applying for this fund.

Section 1: THE BOARD

1. The Board shall base all of its decisions on the Rules and Regulations found in this document.
2. The Board shall be made up of Six (6) members:
 - a. The KSU President, who will chair these meeting and have the Casting vote;
 - b. The Vice President
 - c. The KSU Financial Officer
 - d. A representative from the University of Malta Rectorate;
 - e. Two (2) current University of Malta Students;
3. The term of office of the Board shall be from November 2018 till June 2019.
4. A decision shall not be taken if less than four (4) members are present.
5. The Board is at liberty to draft the criteria to determine the acceptance of an application.

Section 2: THE FUND

1. The fund is created from the collection of the €3 Green contribution collected with every KSU Parking Permit issued. Any third party willing to contribute to the fund in cash or kind can do so.
2. The Fund will be issued in instalments for separate initiatives and projects related to sustainability.
3. Each instalment will be capped separately as deemed necessary by the board.
4. The criteria for application for each instalment are to be decided by the Board.
5. A call for sustainability-related projects will be issued. All students enrolled at the University of Malta will be eligible to apply.
6. The Fund will be capped once no more KSU student's parking permits are issued for the academic year 2018/2019.
7. Should there be any part of the Fund which remains unused it can be carried over to the Green Fund announced the year after. If the Green Fund is discontinued the Board should take a decision regarding how the remaining funds will be used.

Section 3: VALIDITY OF APPLICATION

1. Applications are to be received by not later than Friday 28th June, 2019.
2. No applications will be accepted after the stipulated dates.
3. Students can apply for more than one instalment of the fund; however preference will be given to those who have not yet benefitted from the Fund.
4. Students must be enrolled in a full time – part time undergraduate or post-graduate course at the University of Malta during the applications closes.

Section 4: FUNDING

1. No payment will be issued without evidence of fiscal receipts and any further evidence as deemed necessary by the Board.
2. KSU must be able to supervise the installation or implementation of the project – initiative – installation.
3. If no applications are found eligible for funding KSU takes it upon itself to carry out a project under the scope of this grant.

Section 4: Applying for Fund

1. The following documents should be presented upon collection of funds:

- ✓ **A valid ID Card**
- ✓ **Screen Shot of the University ESims Account showing your current Course Details.**
- ✓ **Copy of Fiscal Receipt of Administration Fee Payment**
