



## **CAMPAIGN+ REGULATIONS 2017/2018**

- Student life shall be at the centre of the campaign and must have tangible educational outcomes. It should embrace the values of the council and of the university.
- Successful proposals require an element of sustainability and green responsibility. Gender neutrality and respect towards students' needs are to be maintained.
- Applicants can be individual students currently enrolled as part-time or full-time students at the University of Malta, group of students currently enrolled as part-time or full-time students at the University of Malta or as a student on behalf of a student organisation. KSU reserves the right to withhold or demand back any disbursed funds if applicants are not part-time or full-time students at the University of Malta.
- Proposals must reach the KPS office via email on socialpolicy@ksu.org.mt by no later than the 1st of November 2017 at 00:00. The KSU Social Policy Office will subsequently select the best proposal in line with the theme specification.
- The entity submitting the chosen proposal will not be eligible to submit other applications in any other calls within this funding opportunity throughout the term.
- The maximum budget for each project is that of 300eur only. These will be refunded upon presentation of all VAT receipts to the KSU financial officer within stipulated dates by the Social Policy Office. All expenses have to be directly related to the implementation of the campaign and 2 to 3 quotes need to be submitted to the KPS Office prior to proceeding with purchase.
- Failure of implementation within the stipulated dates due to negligence from the team submitting the project may result in losing the eligibility for funding.
- It is the responsibility of the entity submitting the proposal to implement and carry out any necessary follow-ups within the specified timeframe and ensure constant consultancy with the KPS office.
- The KPS office will overlook the strategy and implementation of the campaign and offer assistance if the need arises.
